SPA SCHOOL 101

#1 Rule – NEVER TURN POWER ON TO AN EMPTY TUB!

1. WHEN READY TO FILL, REMOVE FILTER HOUSING AND FILTERS. Put hose in one of the open holes (this will fill plumbing first and then the tub itself)
2. Your tub is full when all jets are covered (with water)
3. Remove hose and turn on power for your tub. (breaker = ON/OFF switch)
4. Turn heat to 95 degrees. Once the tub reaches the set temperature begin to add chemicals
5. Take the blue cartridge (change every 4 months) and attach it to the grey SmartChlor cartridge (change 1 time per month). Throw the ball into your tub after setting dial to 4 on the SmartChlor cartridge.
6. Open the packet of Jumpstart and add all contents from packet into the water.
7. Run/turn on all jets. The jets will run for 20 minutes and automatically turn off.
8. After the 20-minute cycle is completed, place a test strip/dip the test strip halfway into your tub water. After a few seconds, remove the strip and match 4 to the back of the test strip tube.
9. Top Box = SmartChlor if no color on test strip this indicates the SmartChlor cartridge must be changed.
10. The second and third Box = Ph & Alkalinity and be certain in ideal ranges. If too high or too low, use Ph/Alkalinity up or down (measure accordingly).
Run the jets again, once in the ideal ranges on the test strips, the tub is ready for use.
